Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 11th instant, regarding the freeboards of the s.s. "MARKLAND", Messrs. Earle's S.B. & E.Co's Yard No. 677, I now have to inform you that in view of the construction of the house amidships this cannot be considered as a part of an intact continuous trunk and therefore no allowance can be made in the freeboard computation for this house.

It is observed from the arrangement plan now forwarded that the length of this house appears to be 47'3" instead of 40'6" as given on the freeboard report.

I shall therefore be glad if you will verify this figure and report the amended lengths of the trunks forward and aft.
