We beg to acknowledge your letter of the 28th ultimo respecting the completion of the above vessel's Boiler Survey, and have carefully noted the contents.

We have been in communication with the A.B., who are under the impression that they adjusted the Safety valves of the centre boiler at a date, which is not precise, prior to the Owners' Representative calling our Surveyors to commence the Boiler Survey.

With reference to our Survey, we have to confirm that on the occasion of our last visit viz the 31st December, 1950, the centre boiler had not even been closed up in preparation for raising steam, and it would therefore appear that unless the item has been dealt with at some other port, the safety valves of the centre boiler remain to be adjusted to complete the Boiler Survey.
