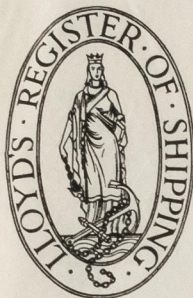

"CORRALES", 5358 tons gross of Glasgow as she lay afloat at Garston on the 9th May, 1961, in order to examine the arrangements made for the ship to be towed as a hulk from Liverpool to a Spanish Port.

The means of securing the closing arrangements to all protective openings and anchor arrangements etc. have been examined and found satisfactory.
