Further to our letter of the 14th instant in reply to your Classing Letter of the 11th instant regarding Sunderland Report No. 33135 "DALTONHALL", we enclose herewith the Makers' test certificates for the priming pump and oil burning fan motors which have now come to hand.

With regard to the test certificates for the generators, we are informed by the Makers - Messrs. Campbell & Isherwood, Ltd. - that test records were lost by enemy action several months ago but that since that date some records have been recovered and that should the certificates be found for these generators, they will be sent on to us.

The generators were found satisfactory on trial on board the ship and there was no sign of undue heating. In the circumstances it is submitted that they might be accepted.
