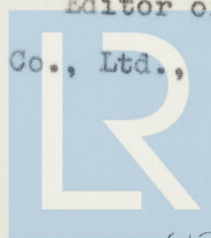
In view of the remarks in the final paragraph of your letter, no action will be taken at present pending your further comments.
