The Managers of the above vessel, Messrs. Craggs & Jenkin Ltd., have taken exception to fees rendered on account of various items, pointing out that they are exceedingly high for such a small vessel.

With the exception of a hull damage fee of 50 guineas, these are practically all scale fees. After careful consideration, we agree that 50 guineas is rather excessive, and suggest that this might be reduced to 38 guineas. It is understood this would meet with the firm's approval.

We shall be grateful for your consideration and instructions.


