Dear Sir,

S.S. "TUNG SONG"

We beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant, reference Freeboard, and have to inform you that the steel forecastle bulkhead fitted between Nos.1 and 2 hatches, is 53 ft. 0 ins. from the forward perpendicular, there is a hinged W.T. steel door fitted on the port side only, 5 ft. by 18 inches with a sill 11 ins. high. We would point out that this is not a watertight bulkhead, there being 5 ins. x 4 ins. drain holes (1 port and 1 starboard) at the bottom of the bulkhead at the shipside.
