With reference to your S. letter of the 23rd instant regarding the "BENOIL", we beg to inform you that the rudder made for this vessel is a copy of that fitted in the s.s. "OAKLAND" (Rot. report No. 30242 and Rot. letter 12-11-47) A verified copy of the plan is enclosed.

The fracture in shell plate F.16 (p.s.) was vertical, about 5" long and situated about 6" forward the cross bulkhead between tanks Nos. 6 and 7 and not in way of any stringers or the like.

I have the regret that the particulars stated above have not been entered in my report.
