Boiler Survey due 9/56 partly held - the machinery is subject to port and starboard combustion chamber back plates being part renewed, as found necessary, all stay tubes welded to combustion chamber tube plates being renewed and a quick closing valve refitted between oil pressure pumps and burners before 4/57, the boiler pressure proposed to be not to exceed 110 lbs. per square inch in the interim period.

Remarks Owners now write they desire one month's further extension until loadline certificate expires, namely 28/5/57 when ship will be sold for scrap.

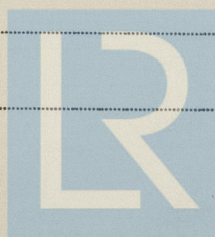
