A coal hatchways 6'x4' at fore end of poop deck now removed and deck openings plated over. Deck houses built at sides (P+S) in way.

Coal hatch at after end of poop deck (P.S) reduced to 3'0"x3'0" and fitted with hinged steel w.T cover with toggles. ✓

Coal hatch 6'0"x4'0" at aft end of poop deck (S.S) removed, and deckhouse built in way having wood door 4'6"x2'3" O.B.S, well 18" high giving access to tween deck spaces below as a companionway.
