
This ship has been under survey at South Shields

EXISTING ESCAPE HATCHES

The coaming to the escape hatch to No.1 hold has been renewed and increased in height to 30" x 24" x 23" x .40" closed by means of steel hinged covers, rubber packing and 7 toggles. ✓

The coaming to the escape hatch to No.2 hold (p.s.) has been renewed and increased in height to 18" x 20½" x 20½" x .40" closed by means of steel hinged covers, rubber packing and toggles. ✓
