the undersigned Surveyors to this Society did at the request of the Owners' representative survey the S.S. "HALVARD BRATT", 1030 tons of Gothenburg formerly classed with the Germanischer Lloyd, on the 12th July, 1945, part loaded, and that the following parts of hull and machinery were examined afloat:

All: Upper parts of holds, fore peak tank, internally, machinery space, structure under boilers, general equipment examined.

Machinery: The main and auxiliary machinery and electrical installation, wiring and fittings, generally examined.

complete survey: Lower parts of hold, aft peak tank and coal bunkers to be examined.

We have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyds Register of Shipping, London, a report stating that we have recommended that there be assigned a record of "Examined L.R. 7,45" in the Register Book on completion of the survey indicating that from the parts seen it appears to be in an efficient condition for a period of 12 months from 7,45, subject to dry docking at first convenient opportunity. The record in the Register Book is also subject to further Mainpiece (EW and reinforced 5,43) being specially examined at next dry docking and to permanent repairs to indented plating (port side) and to stem plate (starboard side) at first convenient opportunity.
