undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owner's Representative survey the s.s. "HALVARD BRATT", 1030 tons of Gothenburg formerly classed with Germanischer Lloyd, on the 6th and 9th July 1945, and that the following parts of the hull were examined afloat viz:-

Decks, casings, erections on Upper Deck, ventilators, hatchways and hatches, steering gear and connections and windlass, and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction and that I have recommended that she be assigned a notation of "Examined L.R.7,45" when the survey of the hull has been completed and the surveys on the machinery and electrical installation have been carried out.

The Record in the Register Book is also subject to Rudder Mainpiece (E.W. & reinforced 5,43) being specially examined at next drydocking and to permanent repairs to indented plating (port side) and to stem plate (starboard side) at first convenient opportunity.
