# Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

This is to Certify that

J. N. P. DOUGLAS,

the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of

the Owners' Representative survey the Steel Screw Steamer "HALVARD BRATT", 1030 tons gross of Gothenberg, formerly classed with the Germanischer Lloyd, on the 26th June and subsequent dates, and that the following parts of hull and machinery were examined in dry dock and afloat, viz:-

Bottom and rudder, cleaned, examined and recoated.  
Propeller, sternbush and outside fastenings examined.  
Holds, 'tween decks, bunkers, structure beneath boilers, fore and aft peaks, machinery spaces, decks, casings, ash shoots, ventilators, hatchways and closing appliances, general equipment, steering gear and connections and windlass.  
Main and auxiliary machinery generally examined, tried under steam and found satisfactory.  
Electrical installation insulation resistance tested and found satisfactory.  
Boilers examined internally and externally; safety valves and other mountings overhauled, found satisfactory.  
Boilers examined under steam and the safety valves adjusted to 200 lbs. per square inch.

and that I have transmitted to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and that I have recommended that she be assigned a notation of EXAMINED L.R. 6,44, indicating that from the parts now seen, she appears to be in an efficient condition for a period of twelve months from 31st June, 1944.

It is also recommended that a record of survey 6.44 and B.S. 6,44 (200 lbs.) be made in the Register Book.
