SOURCE OF INFORMATION

MOON. — Moji, Nov. 18. — Steamer Moon, (Sandakan for Osaka) fully laden, was in collision with motor vessel NISSHUN MARU (Maizuru for Sydney) in forenoon of Nov. 17 in lat. 31 23 N., long. 132 55 E. Moon considered sunk, detected through radar at 6 45 p.m. in lat. 32 15 N., long. 133 17 E. All crew saved, one seriously injured.

Moji, Nov. 18. — Steamer Moon sank at 6 45 p.m., Nov. 17, after collision with motor vessel NISSHUN MARU in forenoon in lat. 31 23 N., long. 132 55 E. — Lloyd's Agents per Salvage Association.

MOON. — Moji, Nov. 20. — Steamer Moon, which sank after collision on Nov. 17, had been bare-chartered for three years by the Kokoku Steamship Company and was insured by Japanese underwriters, mainly by Tokyo Marine-Fire Insurance K.K., Kobe branch. The vessel is now lying at a depth of some 6500 ft. in position lat. 32 19 N., long. 133 18 E., about 29 miles SSE. of Ashizuri Misaki, and refloating is hopeless. (See issue of Nov. 19.)
