Dear Sirs,

M. I have to inform you it is observed from your report No.3076, dated 27th July, 1927, that a freeboard of 8'-9" is now marked on the sides of the s.s. "LOUISIANA", instead of 2'-3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " as given in the Register Book.

It is therefore concluded that the tonnage opening has been permanently closed, that the freeing ports and overboard scuppers from the shelter tween decks have been closed with riveted plates, and that new scuppers have been led to the bilges, but I shall be glad if you will report fully regarding these matters and forward Rpt 12 giving full particulars of the amended ~~freeboard~~ markings.
