Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of Mr. Anander's letter of the 3rd instant respecting the freeboard of the S.S. "LOUEBANKA", from which it would appear that two complete loadline discs with their accompanying seasonal lines are marked on the vessel's sides, although no mention was made of this in your verification of marking form dated 23rd December 1926.

With regard thereto I have to point out that, as freeboard is a condition of the vessel's class, only one disc should be marked, and the centre of this disc should be in accordance with the freeboard approved by the Committee, namely 2'3½" below steel upper deck at side.

You should therefore arrange if possible for the marking to be amended, and forward full particulars to this Office.

The matter is also being taken up with the Society's Surveyors at Oslo.
