Dear Sirs,

I duly received Mr. Roli's letter of the 17th instant, respecting the case of the steamer "LOUISIANA", and note, from an interview which you have had with the Consulting Engineer, that the vessel has again left Oslo but that on her return about the 1st September he will inform you of her arrival, with a view to the freeboard marking being placed in order.

In the circumstances I have to request that you will draw the Owner's attention to the fact that the freeboard which is at present marked is 2" less than that approved by the Committee, and that they must ask the Owner to make definite arrangements for the amended freeboard, which is a condition of the vessel's class, to be marked on her return as now proposed.
