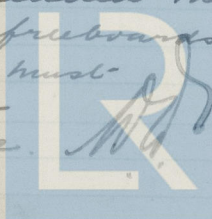


REPORT on the S.S. "LOUISIANA"

It is submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form being those required by the Tables merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to the tonnage opening in the vessel's shelter deck being closed by efficient temporary covers, to the openings in the deck for scuppers leading to the bilges being closed by riveted plates, and to efficient battening arrangements and tarpaulins being fitted to the upper (2nd.) Deck hatchways, as required by the regulations. The Surveyor should be reminded that as freeboard is a condition of class, the freeboards marked on the vessel's sides must not be less than those now assigned by the Committee.
