The annual refit arranged for February, 1958 was deferred by the Admiralty who, on the 21st March, 1958, wrote that no decision had been reached regarding the tanker's future. On the 4th December, 1958 the Admiralty wrote that the ship had been sold. No reply was received to enquiry of the new Owner, but on the 31st January, the Havre Surveyor cabled that the ship was transferring to French ownership at that port.

The Havre Surveyor now states that the ship has been chartered as an oil storage hulk at Le Havre. It is at present intended to use the two donkey boilers for pumping services and the matter of submitting them to survey is under consideration. The Surveyor adds that it does not appear that any overdue survey will be dealt with, as he is advised that the ship will be sold for breaking up in about six months.
