Action has been deferred in the past on account of the vessel being laid up.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will let me know, for the information of the Committee, whether this vessel is still to be laid up and, if not, what arrangements are proposed to be made for the outstanding Surveys and condition of class to receive attention.
