the purpose of carrying out an examination of the vessel afloat, in
order to ascertain that the vessel remained generally in the
condition to comply with the notation applied.

The survey was carried out entirely without prejudice as to
rates and conditions of insurance and similarly without prejudice as
to any agreement concerning arrangements for towing.

At my examination the vessel was found to be in good order,
with regard to hull above water line with all hatches and covers
closed and watertight doors in casings and superstructures closed.

In view of my examinations afloat, the vessel is in condition
to be towed to a South European Port under reasonable weather
conditions subject to any further provisions required by the towing
authorities concerned.
