An Emergency Fire Pump has been fitted in a separate compartment built into the after port corner of the fore hold with an access hatch and ventilator fitted on the upper deck

Access Hatch: Steel coaming 33" above deck x .50" thick

Hatch Dimensions ~ 1'-8" x 2'-2"

Opening in Deck 18" x 24" Oval

fitted with a hinged steel W.I. cover .50" thick and secured by 8 toggles

Ventilator on Foreboard Deck: 6" diameter cowl vent, coaming 36" high above deck x .34 thick and provided with wood plug and canvas cover.
