SOURCE OF INFORMATION

VESTRIA.—Stonehaven Radio, Dec. 16.—Following received from Hernosand Radio:

At 2 40 a.m., G.M.T.: SOS, steamer Vestria, in position 10 miles south of Holmogadd, requires immediate assistance.

At 3 30 a.m., G.M.T.: SOS, Swedish steamer Vestria, in position 10 miles south of Holmogadd, needs immediate assistance.

Hernosand, Dec. 16.—Swedish steamer Vestria has gone aground 10 miles south of Holmogadd.

Holmsund, Dec. 16.—Swedish steamer Vestria with full cargo of timber has gone ashore near Snipangrund; vessel filled with water. Crew has been saved by icebreaker Tarmo.

Vasa, Dec. 16. Steamer Vestria, Karlsborg for Greece with 1100 standards of deals, battens and boards, has been pressed by ice to Snipangrund; vessel filled with water. Crew has been saved by icebreaker Tarmo.

VESTRIA.—Stockholm, Dec. 18.—Swedish steamer Vestria (Kalix for Piraeus) is trapped by ice near Holmogadd. Bottom ripped open, no hope of saving. Crew safe. (See issue of Dec. 17.)

VESTRIA.—Gothenburg, Mar. 1.—Preparations are being made for the salvage of the cargo of the Swedish steamer Vestria, which was lost in Ostra Kvarken before Christmas.—"Svenak Sjöfarts-Tidning." (See issue of Dec. 19.)

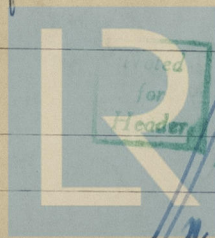
