"WARXOWAUKT = The freeboard assigned is 1'-8" from top of statutory deck line to centre of disc.
"WAVYRWAZEP = The statutory deck line is 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " above the iron (steel) deck at side. The other lines should be marked as follow:- Fresh water 5" above centre of disc.
"WAZYVWEBMO = Indian summer 4" above centre of disc; Winter 4" below centre of disc.
"WEFSUWEMAH = Winter North Atlantic 6" below centre of disc. Subject to efficient temporary covers being fitted over tonnage opening in accordance with the Freeboard rules for shelter deck steamers.
