ALTERATIONS TO CONDITIONS OF ASSIGNMENT OF LOADLINES

Ship's Name "ASSIDUOUS" Official No. 169321.

This ship has been under survey at GIBRALTAR

on 30th October 1954 and the following alterations to the conditions of

assignment of loadlines have now been effected/found:—

Forecastle. The open ends on the Port and Starboard sides now closed in with steel plating welded and efficiently stiffened between the ship's side and the deck house. A strongly framed and constructed hinged steel watertight door 5'-6" x 2'-0" with 18 inch sill is fitted at each side. These doors can be closed from either side. All freeing ports and other openings in the closed in part of the forecastle plated over and made watertight.
