In reply to the Secretary's letter of 23rd April, 1947, we herewith forward Reports in connection with survey of General Examination for class contemplated including part Special Survey. A First Entry Report together with Freeboard Reports C11 and C11(comp) will be forwarded later.

The survey fees have been omitted from Report 8 meantime pending the decision of the Committee and in this connection we submit the following fees proposed to be charged. With regard to these fees it is pointed out that to suit the Owners convenience a general Examination has been held as it was not possible to carry out the full Special Survey in the time available.

Re-class vessel under 5 years £31x2	=	£62
General Examination under 8000 tons	=	16
Freeboard	=	18
Total fee, if Survey carried out in U.K.	=	£96
