we have recommended that she be classed THAT we have on this ship, carried out such examination relating to the safety, to which the ship subjected for the obtainment of the said class;


AND THAT we have ascertained that the ship is in a seaworthy condition with regard to her employment and trade in which she is intended to be i.e. in the foreign going trade.
