Dear Sir,

In reply to the question in the classing letter of the 11th inst., regarding the S.S. "CITY OF GLASGOW" (No. 15861) I beg to state that the spare gear included a bucket and rod for the lubricating oil circulating pumps, and two thermometers for oil circulating system.

The remainder of the spare gear is in accordance with the Rules, except that the main thrust block, being a totally enclosed block with ring bearings top and bottom, with forced lubrication and water jacket top and bottom, no spare shoes were supplied.

A plan of this thrust block will be sent in a few days for your information.
