Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 5th instant, respecting the case of the new s.s. "CITY OF GLASGOW, Messrs. Wm. Gray & Co(1918) Ltd., No.897 vessel, and in view of the fact that the survey of this vessel was completed on the 31st ultimo, the fees for the special survey during construction of the hull and machinery should be charged on the old scale.

As regards the fees for the survey of the turbine machinery, the Nominal Horse Power in this case is 632, and the fees per Rule will therefore be:-

First entry fee.....	£3:	0:	0
Survey fee.....	51:	12:	0

and an account should be rendered to the Builders accordingly.

I have also to add that the fees for the survey of the refrigerating appliances will be charged from the Society's Liverpool Office, who are being advised in regard to the matter. You will, however, be good enough to advise the Liverpool Surveyors as to the completion of the survey.
