Attached is our machinery report No. for  
the Machinery Special Survey of the above vessel.

It is understood that there is a possibility of a claim  
being made against the underwriters for delay caused  
in consequence of this survey.

We have to advise you that the Owners experienced  
great difficulties in having machinery items opened  
up for survey due to the existing labour shortage at  
this port, added with the fact that during the survey  
the Superintendents were changed which also caused some  
difficulties in progressing the work.

As the Owners had committed the vessel to a  
charter, every assistance was given on our part to  
prevent any delays, and as will be noted from the  
report certain repairs were left outstanding with  
the foregoing in mind. It is regretted that you  
were not advised by telegram of this situation.

As all the Main Machinery was examined at this  
time, it is considered that the record of E.S. 7.57  
could be recommended, to coincide with the hull  
SS notation.
