Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines  
in

NEW ACCOMMODATION IN POOP.

Accommodation for gun's crews has been erected in poop space. Access is by a steel companionway, of strong construction, attached to aft end, port side poop deck crew wash house, and closed by a wood door 4'-6" x 20' x 16" high, with spring lock capable of operation from both sides.

An emergency exit has been made by cutting a doorway in aft side of tunnel escape, which passes through new accommodation, closed by steel door secured by hand-levers & wedges.

Two washbasins and one lavatory are fitted in port side of accommodation, discharges being fitted with stem valves.
