It is submitted the Surveyor be informed that subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on completion, the ends of sections being closed as required for all allowance, the hatchways and ports on awning deck being in accordance with Rule A Rec. 52 of the Rules and no scuppers or other openings being cut in the vessel's sides to affect position of the loadline disc, the approximate summer freeboard would be 5'-11" from statutory deck line $1\frac{3}{4}$ " over shell awning deck at side, with scantlings as amended on the revised plans.

The minimum freeboard is desired to be about 4'-10" from statutory deck line $1\frac{3}{4}$ " above shell awning deck at side, it will be necessary to increase the scantlings as follows.

main frames increased to	$6 \times 3 \times .40$ angle	bent
awning deck struts	" "	.50
" " sheerstrake	" "	.65
side strake and } strake below }	" "	.55

Builders should be requested to state which plan they decide to adopt in order that provisional approval may be issued.
