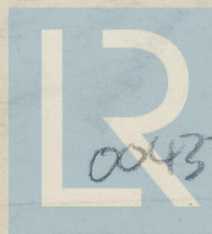
I have spoken to-day with them and they have promised that the drawings will be submitted this week without fail and further that such diagrammatic drawings for future vessels will be submitted at once.
