This is a complete superstructure vessel with tonnage opening and the scantlings are in accordance with the Rule requirements for this type.

The inner bottom plating has been increased in thickness under the hatchways, but ceiling has also been fitted.

To improve the stability of the vessel arrangements for ballast as stated on page 4, have been made.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the Rules and the approved plans, and it is submitted she is eligible to be classed **LOCAL "With freeboard" "Fitted for oil fuel 6.47 FP above 150°F". 6.47 Sld.**
