In reply to London letter ref. Clasen (S) dated 12th June, 1952, regarding the First Entry report of the refrigerating machinery of the above vessel, the temperatures should read as follows:-

Atmosphere 58°F, Cooling water inlet 52°F - Outlet 55°F,  
Gas condensers 68°F.

Regarding the drainage of spaces and cooler trays, sealed scuppers 2½" I.D. are fitted, two in each space, forward and aft, outboard, also sealed drains 1" I.D. one in each cooler tray, all led direct to Engine room and lower hold bilges respectively.
