Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in _____

One Emergency escape scuttle fitted in shell plating in way of steering gear compartment, opening 21" dia., coaming 2" x 1/2" closed by a 3/8" thick stiffened hinged steel watertight cover, secured by a strong steel strongback and screw, the strongback fitted with a strong retaining chain secured to shell. Fitted with notice plate warning persons not to open the scuttle except during an emergency.

A copy of this memorandum has been placed on board the vessel.
