EXAMINATION AND REPAIRS AS PER RULE FOR Docking & Gen.Exam. for voyage to a Far East Port as an Unclassed Vessel.

W. & T. Repairs

Local wastage in way of keel plate of No.2 Cargo Tank doubled.

Several scattered wasted rivets cap welded.

Fracture in way of No.5 port cargo tank bottom plating veed out and substantial doubling plate fitted in way.

Sundry other minor repairs effected.

S.R.L. Items Repairs to set up bottom plating etc. (p & sf) specially examined and found to remain efficient.

Defective side shell rivets in way of Nos.2,3 & 6 cargo oil tanks (s.s.) of O.F. bunkers (p & s) examined, the worst leakages were temporarily repaired by caulking.

All S.R.L. items are considered satisfactory for the contemplated voyage to a Far East Port for breaking up purposes.

S.R.L. Appendix examined and remain efficient.

The above items were examined and found satisfactory in my opinion for the General examination to a Far East Port as an unclassified vessel. (Vessel proceeding in ballast condition).
