When the vessel was under survey at Auckland on the 26th November last, the Surveyor examined the main engine No. 6 bottom end bearing and found the white metal to be fractured and slack in several places, and the Committee have therefore continued the machinery class subject, inter alia, to the main engine No.6 bottom end bearing being specially examined by the end of February, 1968.

The Auxiliary Boiler Survey becomes due at the end of March, 1968, and your intentions regarding this inspection, and the above condition of class will be appreciated in due course.

I would point out that as this vessel is on an extended Special Survey basis, about 50% of the survey should have been completed by the due date i.e. 3.68, and arrangements should be made for this to be done by that time.
