Motorship "NANCHANG"

Following the survey carried out by the Society's Auckland Surveyors in February last, it was recommended that the Auxiliary boiler be raised to the maximum safe working pressure (100 lbs. per sq. in.) the smoke tubes, throat plate and Ogee ring seams be examined for leakage at the next Auxiliary Boiler Survey, and not later than the end of April, 1967.

The Committee have, therefore, continued the ship's class subject, inter alia, to this matter receiving attention by the time stated.

As you will be aware, in the near future it will be necessary to have a Cargo Ship Safety Construction Certificate on board the above ship.

In this case, at least an Annual Classification Survey will require to be held, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you propose to make in this respect.
