m.s. "NANCHANG"

I enclose a copy of a letter dated the 6th March addressed to the Secretary, Liverpool who now states that the outstanding survey matters will probably be dealt with at Yokohama towards the end of the present month.

I may add that the class is at present continued subject to No.4 hatchway coamings (port) on centre castle deck (temporarily repaired 9.66) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the Special Survey, to D.B. air pipe in No.3 hold and to 'tween deck bulkheads at after end of No.2 hold being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking, to all starting air pipes except three lengths of main starting air pipes for bottom cylinders being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking, also to the auxiliary boiler being raised to maximum safe working pressure (100 psi) the smoke tubes, throat plate and ogee ring seams examined for leakage at the next ABS but not later than the end of April, 1967.
