As a result of this inspection the ship's class has been continued subject, inter alia, to the following items receiving attention by the times stated:-

1. The wasted No.2/3 hold and 'tween deck bulkheads in way of No.2 access trunk way being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of 12.66.
2. The No.3 aft air pipe (port) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary by the end of 2.67.

I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you propose to make regarding the above subjects.
