Doubling plate welded to rudder where corroded.

Lower rudder pintle bush renewed.

Doubling plate welded to upper deck for'd of No.5 hatch where worn and thin.

Doubling plate welded to centre girder in bilge wells in deep tanks where badly corroded.

S.R.L. No.250:- 2 fathoms worn chain cable, ps, to be renewed or removed at the earliest opportunity, now removed and new short length fitted. See Rpt.8(EQ) attached.

S.R.L. Appendix No.17:- Stem plating in way of B strake indented - Nothing done at this time. Examined and found to remain efficient.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated. I recommend, therefore, that this ship remain as classed with/without fresh record of dry docking 2.66 subject to any outstanding conditions of the vessel's class being dealt with as previously recommended but without condition regarding removal of 2 fathoms worn chain cable.

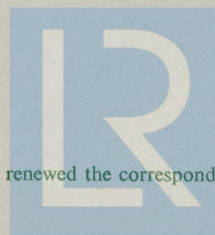
