CLASSING LETTER.

14799 "STRAAT PUTAMI". This ship has today been classed +100A1 "Tunnel side tanks in No.4. hold - Vegetable Oil, Latex or Molasses", together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

I enclose herewith Rotterdam Report 4c (ICR) No.59911, and shall be glad if you will complete the Installation Declaration.

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated the 12th November, the contents of which have been noted.

14902 "UMEKO". This ship has today been classed +100A1 "Oil Tanker", together with the appropriate notations recommended by you.

14868 "ASIA ENTERPRISES" ex "SHAUKIWAN". As recommended, except that a record of DS 9,65, has been assigned, and the hull class has been continued subject to port and starboard bower anchors being repaired and retested and the spare bower anchor being replaced by one of Rule size at the earliest opportunity, to upper deck plates, first inboard from stringer abreast No.4. hatchway (port and starboard) being renewed, and adjacent plating being examined and dealt with as necessary, temporary manilla rope and wood block of auxiliary steering gear being replaced by S.W.R.

and block, and to set up shell plating (port and starboard) with structure in way and buckled D.B. floors being specialy examined and dealt with as necessary by completion of the Special Survey.

14953 "SUMIDA MARU". As recommended.

According to the records in this Office, the following machinery items have not been seen for more than four years, and the Owners should be requested to make the necessary arrangements for these items to be surveyed as soon as possible.

Main Engine No.1. connecting rod, top end and guides, crankpin and bearing.
Starboard fresh water circulating pump.

15121 "KIMIKAWA MARU" RMC. As recommended, except that a notation of RS 11,65, has been assigned, and I shall be glad if you will issue an amended Interim Certificate accordingly.
