In reply to your letter of the 17th May, I have to say that provided a satisfactory General Examination of the hull and machinery is held at an early date, the Committee will then be prepared to consider the postponement of the Special Survey until some time before the end of May 1966, as proposed. In this connection, I have to point out that no arrangements have been made for the vessel's machinery to be surveyed on the Continuous Survey basis.

I shall now be glad to learn what arrangements are made for the General Examination to be held shortly, and with regard thereto have to say that the considerably overdue Main Boiler Survey should be completed at that time.
