We would refer to your letter of July 26th 1966 contents of which we have noted and beg to reply as follows:-

Completion of Main Boiler Survey:- We would advise you that during the vessel's passage from Port Said earlier this month the Master of the vessel was asked to have his vessel's Starboard Boiler ready for the purpose of passing the Survey and in this respect your Port Said Surveyor was called to attend this requirement on Sunday 21st instant. We have now been advised by the Master that your Surveyor did call to the vessel and that the necessary examination of this Boiler was carried out with the exception of testing the Boiler under steam, as the Master for the purpose of avoiding keeping his vessel waiting at Port Said for the time required to raise steam, had asked your Surveyor to postpone this requirement until the return of the vessel to Port Said after loading in the Black Sea namely during the course of next month. We understand that your Surveyor has agreed to the Master's request and we have therefore asked the Master to cable your Surveyor in Port Said when the vessel is nearing there so that arrangements may be made for your Surveyor to board the vessel and complete the annual Survey examination for the Starboard Boiler.

Main Circulating Pump Casing:- During the vessel's short stay at Port Said the Master of the vessel on the instructions of his Owners asked your Surveyor to examine the Main Circulating Pump for the purpose of obtaining the required extension until the part in question is delivered to the vessel. The Master has advised us that your Surveyor after examining the Main Circulating Pump is recommending that the present

requirement for this item be dealt with by the next Dry-Docking of the vessel.

No doubt you have already received or you will soon receive the report of your Port Said Surveyor regarding the above.

We take this opportunity to advise you that on instructions from the Owners we have managed to secure a new Casing for the Main Circulating Pump and this has been forwarded to Port Said in order that it be delivered to the vessel when she passes Port Said during the next month. We enclose photostat Certificate which we obtained from the Sellers of the said Casing and trust you will find same to be in order. The Owners have advised us that they propose to attend to the renewal of the said Casing during the vessel's next Dry-Docking which they intend to arrange when the vessel completes her present voyage from the Black Sea to Japan or if this is not possible some time thereafter and we will advise you accordingly when the definite arrangements for Dry-Docking are made. Meantime we shall be pleased to have your Committee's agreement for the postponement of the vessel's annual Dry-Docking which as you know is due next month, First year.
