Reverting to your letter of the 20th ultimo respecting Glasgow First entry report No.70085 on the steamer "EMPIRE CRUSOE", Mr. Watson has confirmed that he is prepared to recommend the electrical installation for class subject to the two electric generator name plates being altered to show 11 K.W. 100 amps. and their fuse elements changed to 100 amp. rating, and as the official classification certificate will bear this qualification, it will not be necessary to write any letter either to the Managers or to the D.D.M.B. unless you consider it politic to let Messrs. Glen & Co. know.
