The LONDON Surveyors report (10.49) ship examined on slipway, bottom coated, the requirements of a SPECIAL SURVEY TYPE 1 complied with and, on account of wear and tear, a few repairs effected.

The main engine seating has now been modified to suit new engine installed at this time. The seating is in accordance with plans previously approved for this class of ship.

IT IS SUBMITTED this ship is worthy to remain as classed by the British Corporation, with record of docking 9.49, and to have notations of "ss. Lon.- 10.49" and "Annual Survey 10.49".
