I have also to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo, returning the classification certificate for the machinery of the vessel, and in accordance with your suggestion the port of "Middlesbrough" has been added as one of the ports where the machinery of this vessel was surveyed.

As regards the question of the allocation of the machinery fees, I have to say that in accordance with the usual practice the full amount due for the survey of the boilers during construction will be credited to Glasgow on payment, and no alteration will be made in the allocation of the fees in this case, as set forth in my letter of the 27th ultimo.
