Dear Sir,

With reference to the enclosed certificate for the Turbine machinery of the steamer "ANDALUSIER", we think it as well to point out that as this vessel is fitted with Babcock and Wilcox water-tube boilers, the various parts of which were made at Glasgow but were erected and tested by hydraulic on board the vessel at this port. In view of this it is suggested that Middlesbrough should be added to the ports of Newcastle and Glasgow, as ports where this machinery was surveyed.

We may add that in allocating the fees to the various ports, we are of opinion that this port has not been credited with a due proportion for the survey during erection and testing of the boilers.
